**Faculty/Staff Recommendation Guidelines for
Larry R. Miller Scholarship Nominees**

I. General

Larry R. Miller served with distinction at Illinois State University from 1971 until his death in January 1993. A significant quality which characterized Larry Miller was his pursuit of excellence. As a teacher in the Department of Technology, he challenged and assisted students to exceed the expectations they set for themselves. As the Associate Dean of the College of Applied Science and Technology, he worked tirelessly and succeeded in making quality improvements in planning, facilities and equipment, and operations within the College. He will be remembered for his positive attitude, vision, and commitment to his work. This scholarship has been established by Larry's family and friends to perpetuate the pursuit of quality, which motivated him. **Recipients are awarded a \$1,500 stipend and their names are added to a permanent plaque in the College office.**

II. Qualifications

1. The candidate must be an undergraduate enrolled with a major in a program in the College and have completed 30 hours at ISU.
2. The candidate must have a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher.
3. The candidate's collegiate experiences should reflect exceptional achievement and creativity which have enhanced their professional growth. This achievement should be in addition to and beyond receiving a high GPA.
4. The candidate must show evidence of leadership, participation, and accomplishment in Departmental, School, College and/or University activities.
5. The candidate must demonstrate accomplishments that have a positive effect on the Department, School, College and/or University.
6. The candidate must demonstrate superior personal characteristics reflective of Larry R. Miller; such as, honesty, integrity, high moral and ethical standards, vision, positive attitude and commitment.

III. Selection

The scholarship recipient will be selected annually by the College of Applied Science and Technology Awards Committee from among the nominees from each department or school in the College, with approval from the Dean. The Student Information form must be accompanied by at least two letters of recommendation from full-time faculty/staff within the College supporting the personal qualities and accomplishments of the student.

Please keep the above criteria in mind when writing the recommendation. Faculty recommendations should be submitted by the student with his/her Student Information form.
